




#### 290% INCREASE IN AVAILABLE CAPITAL FOR KC ENTREPRENEURS

KCSourceLink has been tracking the pools of investment capital available to early-stage companies in Kansas City.

Funds include grant programs (e.g., Digital Sandbox KC and LaunchKC); angel groups (e.g., Mid-America Angels, Women's Capital Connection, Northland Angel Investor Network); KC-based funds (e.g., Flyover Capital, Firebrand Ventures, KCRise Fund); and firms based outside Kansas City that have indicated significant interest in investing in KC area companies (Lewis & Clark Venture Capital, Dundee Venture Capital, Drive Capital).



# 4,679 KC STARTUPS HIRED THEIR FIRST EMPLOYEES IN 2015

KC's entrepreneurs launch new businesses that create jobs and spark economic growth. On average, 4,400 KC-area startups hire their first employees each year.\*

The number of first-time employers has been consistent across industries, with "services, education, administration" ranking highest. "Innovation-led" accounts for about 12.5 percent of the startups in 2015. This includes a wide range of firms, including aerospace, architectural engineering, computer hardware and software, telecommunications, pharmaceutical/medicine production and scientific research. Health care services jumped after 2012 due in part to a change in industry classification from other services into health care services.

\*Startup is defined as first-time employers in the nine-county, Kansas City area who paid for unemployment insurance in Kansas or Missouri.


