Growth Initiative (UBGI)

and counseling to create
jobs and support urban
business growth.

UBGI ensures successful outcomes in our urban core by identifying, assessing and supporting an active pipeline of clients with diverse training opportunities and counseling. Through a strong partnership of entrepreneurial resources, UBGI provides a seamless process that is developing and strengthening businesses in Kansas City, Missouri's urban core.

With 92 scholarships and 119 counseling sessions, UBGI helped its businesses generate more than \$29.5 million in new sales and almost \$4.3 million in new investment capital.* With twice the revenue and business investments of last year's results, that impact shows that UBGI is doing its part to build opportunities in the urban core and help make Kansas City America's most entrepreneurial city.

UBGI is a collaboration of KC BizCare (the City of Kansas City, Missouri Business Customer Service Center), the UMKC Small Business and Technology Development Center (SBTDC), the Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC), Justine PETERSEN, the Women's Business Center and KCSourceLink. Funding for the Urban Business Growth Initiative comes from the City of Kansas City, Missouri, and the U.S. Small Business Administration.

Joshua Lewis and UpDown Nightlife

On any given night there are so many great things going on around Kansas City that it's hard to choose what to do (not to mention planning the whole thing). Joshua Lewis and the UpDown Nightlife app are poised to solve that problem in Kansas City and beyond. The social app allows fun-seekers the ability to see what's hot around town and plan their evening at the click of a button.

Joshua knew he wanted to create an app to help party-goers "turn up" or "get down," but to get traction and garner outside investment, he needed to build a business to support his dream.

After his first pitch to Digital Sandbox KC, Joshua was advised to apply for an Urban Business Growth Initiative scholarship, take FastTrac® TechVenture™ and receive coaching from a UMKC Small Business and Technology Development Center technology commercialization consultant. The eight-session course helped Joshua build a business plan and empower his team. At the end of 2015, Joshua received proof-of-concept support from Digital Sandbox KC, and the UpDown Nightlife app launched in Kansas City in September of 2016.

Kansas City nights will never be the same.
